Dear Chairman Lawrence:

The Presidents Island community has been experiencing an increase in criminal and suspicious activity in the last 6 to 12 months. The Memphis Police Department is working numerous cases on Presidents Island. I would like to encourage the industries on Presidents Island to help us deter additional activity by being more vigilant and proactive.

Attached with this letter is an Emergency Contact Card that was created by the Area Maritime Committee for regulated facilities. The list is also appropriate for general use by all facilities. The card provides who to call in case of an actual incident, suspicious activity or a breach of security. A desktop, waterproof, version of the card can be picked up at the Port Commission office. I would suggest that industry also print the card and place it in prominent locations for quick reference.

Lastly, if you have a property crime, report it to the Memphis Police Department. Assignment of police cars is influenced by statistical reporting of crime within designated areas. Not reporting property crimes makes it harder to justify placement of a car on the island at night.

A criminal's greatest ally is lack of vigilance. If they know they are being watched, they will move to other targets. Let's increase our vigilance and work together to make Presidents Island an unattractive target for crime.
